TTF Family,

Over the last two years, God's favor and the support of so many have enabled us to gain ground in the fight against human trafficking and child sexual exploitation. In partnership with like-minded ministries across the globe and the commitment of more than 10,000 people on our Rescue Team, we have had the opportunity to help rescue thousands of victims from their circumstances and provide hope and care to survivors.

The victims and survivors of human trafficking and exploitation are constantly on our hearts and minds. Those that are being hurt often times by the very people who should be protecting them, the children who live in poverty and are sold by their families, and the many who are stolen and sexually exploited by offenders around the world. Sometimes the magnitude of this issue can be overwhelming thinking about the many men, women, and children trapped in this darkness across the globe.

Today, we want to share with you a specific problem we **ALL** continue to face. A problem that exists in every state, every city, every community, and countless homes – even those that may look just like yours. Child sexual abuse material is rampant across the world right now. Pictures and videos of children being sexually exploited and abused circulate continually by the hundreds of millions. These images are traded like baseball cards between offenders everywhere. The circulation of these images normalizes the sexual abuse of children and fuels a global demand for new images.

Child sexual exploitation and abuse come in many forms. A majority of children are sexually exploited and abused by people in their circle of trust, while children that are sexually exploited online can be groomed by strangers and coerced to send photos and videos. For survivors of these crimes, images of their abuse – **the worst moments of their childhood**—are allowed to be redistributed infinitely. In some instances, offenders stalk them, gather to discuss harming them, and even find where they live, work, and go to school. These victims have no recourse, no way to make it stop, no way to feel safe.

BUT TOGETHER, WE CAN FORGE A PATH TOWARD A SOLUTION.

Prevention is key to moving the needle in this fight. We must have conversations with our children about this issue, so we can make offenders' tactics ineffective. We need to advocate for legal change to protect more children on a global scale. We won't gain ground in the fight against child exploitation until perpetrators know there is an army of people standing against them.

The truth is while we have seen victories, and the impact we have had in the last few years is encouraging, we aren't winning this war right now. But no matter how daunting, no matter the darkness we encounter, we don't have a choice but to stand for what is right. In John 1:5, we are told that, "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it."

We need warriors who are ready and willing to engage in this fight if we are going to bring an end to this atrocity. Alone, it can be easy to lose heart, but when we stick together as a team, we are stronger, and we can take heart because we know Who wins.
